A Message from Pastor Kyle Hardin

My name is Kyle Hardin and it is a pleasure for us to be able to meet you. You might say that I never chose the vocation of ministry, but rather that God chose me for it. As a child, and even a young man, I never preferred to be in front of people, yet God has given me a great desire to know God and make Him known. My wife is a big part of that.

See, I grew up in a family of construction workers in the upstate of South Carolina who built houses for over 25 years. And even though I grew up doing construction, I knew I did not want to continue with it indefinitely. I went to Erskine College to play baseball right out of high school, but I left Erskine to go into the Navy to be able to finish paying for school. While I was in the Navy, God began placing a call on my life to ministry, but He did not make where or how clear at that time. I considered going to Moody Bible Institute with a fellow serviceman who went there when we got out of the Navy, but God's call was not clear yet and I went back home to South Carolina. Shortly after this, I met Shelly, and God used her to make things perfectly clear. We were married in November of 2000 and began to attend a church where the Word of God was preached verse by verse and we began to grow in our faith exponentially. In 2004, God made it clear that we were to give up our self-employed construction business and move to Louisville, Kentucky to attend Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. Our seminary journey was long, but God deepened my desire to study diligently and consistently and proclaim His Word well.

In our 8+ years in ministry, I have held many offices from Small Group Leader to Senior Pastor. We strive for our family to be centered on the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and you can expect our ministry to be one centered on the Word of God and to be driven by it.
