

years now. We usually average 40-75 shoeboxes for this project. The drop location used in November was the St Andrews Presbyterian Church. They recently sent information about the total shoeboxes received and distributed in 2021.

The worldwide total was 10,505,155 shoeboxes which was above the goal set by Operation Christmas Child. This number includes shoeboxes from the US and all other participating countries.

The US total was 9,127,491 shoeboxes which was an all-time record. Although donations from our church were a small part of these totals, we appreciate everyone who made a shoebox or donated toward the postage for shipping the boxes.

Meetings of the Ladies Outreach are held each month at 10 a.m. in the Family Life Center, and all ladies are invited to attend. The ladies prepare a gift for one of the shut-ins each month, and each team member brings items to include, such as lotion, tissues, puzzle books, snacks, etc.. The April meeting is scheduled for April 13th, and the May meeting will be held on May 18th.
